

CAN YOU MAKE A BUTTERFLY?







You will need:

- An empty Del Monte Fruit Can
- An A4 sheet of coloured corrugated paper
- A pencil
- Scissors
- PVA glue
- Optional decorative items e.g. decorative paper, foam shapes, stickers, glitter.

Method:

- Ask an adult to soak the can to remove the label; and thoroughly clean and dry it for you.
- Paint or wrap the can in decorative paper. Draw a nice smiley face on the front!
- Using a pencil, draw the shape of two butterfly wings on the corrugated paper. Add a tab shape on the inside of each wing.
- Carefully cut out the wings, and fold the tabs backwards. Add glue to the tabs and stick one to each side of the can.
- To make the antennae, cut two thin strips of the paper. Ask an adult to curl the ends of these strips using scissors and stick them to the inside of the front of the can.

Be careful: Make sure you have an adult supervising and be careful of sharp edges!
